Explore the family friendly 5km return walk beginning at Federation corner on the raised boardwalk and discover Newlands Lake & Boikerbert swamp. This tranquil walk weaves through an everchanging landscape that offers new experiences every season.

Newlands Reserve spans 258 hectares of remnant bushland.



## MOSAIC TRAIL

The Newlands Mosaic Trail is an artistic initiative featuring a collection of 18 tiles, each adorned with depictions of flora and fauna.

These designs are inspired by the diverse species found within Newlands Reserve.

Created by talented local artists, the joint project with Edenhope Flora Reserve celebrates the natural beauty and biodiversity of the area. It was made possible through the generous support of the Victorian Government's Volunteer Innovation Fund.



Apsley Bushland Reserve includes a mix of woodland types, predominately red gum swamp with open grassy understory and heathy woodland with brown stringy bark, manna gum and yellow gum canopy with shrub and herb understory.

The Reserve is home to many iconic Australian species, Kangaroos, Emus, Echidnas and Red-tail black cockatoos can often be found in the reserve.

As you move through the reserve closer towards Newlands Lake and Boikerbert Swamp the air is filled with sounds of calling frogs. Birdwatchers can expect to see Ducks, Heron, Eagles, Spoonbills as well as many woodland bird species.
